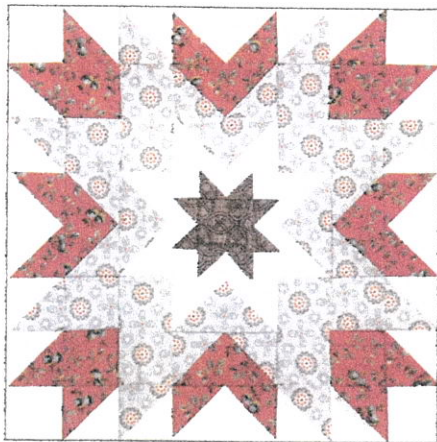

Red Print

- 8 squares (A) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ "
- 1 square (B) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "
- 4 squares (E) 2 " x 2 "

Cream Solid

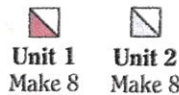
- 12 squares (A) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ "
- 1 square (B) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "
- 1 square (C) $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ "
- 4 squares (E) 2 " x 2 "
- 4 squares (G) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $1\frac{1}{4}$ "

Aqua Print

- 8 squares (A) $2\frac{3}{8}$ " x $2\frac{3}{8}$ "
- 1 square (B) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " x $4\frac{1}{4}$ "
- 4 squares (E) 2 " x 2 "
- 4 rectangles (F) 2 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

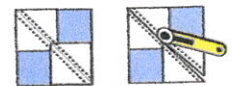
Brown Tone-on-Tone

- 4 squares (D) $1\frac{5}{8}$ " x $1\frac{5}{8}$ "
- 1 square (E) 2 " x 2 "

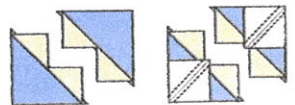


Fast Flying Geese*

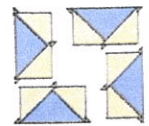
Align 2 small squares on opposite corners of the large square, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line as shown and then stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " out from both sides of the line. Cut apart on the marked line.



With the small squares on top, open out the small squares and press the unit. On the remaining corner of each of these units, align a small square. Draw a line from corner to corner and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " out on both sides of the line. Cut on the marked lines, open the small squares and press.



Each set of 1 large square and 4 small squares makes 4 Flying Geese.



Triangle-Squares*

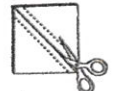
With right sides together and the lighter fabric on top, pair one square of each color that makes the unit. On the lighter patch, draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.



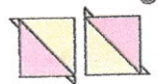
Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " out from both sides of the line.

Cut apart on the marked line.

With the darker fabric up, open out the top patch and press the unit.

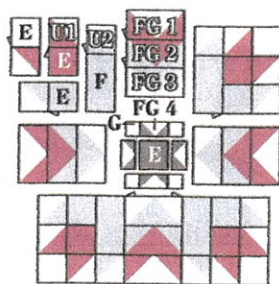


A pair of squares will yield 2 units.



Refer to the "Triangle-Squares" technique on page 86. Pair 4 red A's with cream A's to make 8 unit 1's. Use 4 aqua A's and cream A's to make 8 unit 2's.

Refer to the "Fast Flying Geese" technique on page 86. Use a cream B with red A's to make 4 Flying Geese 1's. Use a red B with aqua A's to make 4 Flying Geese 2's. Use an aqua B with cream A's to make 4 Flying Geese 3's. To make 4 Flying Geese 4's, use a cream C with brown D's.



Block Assembly

Sew the units, Flying Geese and patches together as shown to complete the block. ■
