Oct 2015 block of the month

12 1/2 x 12 1/2" unfinished

TIPS: Shorten your stitch length because you will be sewing some very short seams. Not all seam intersections nest so you may wish to press seams open.

Background (cream in picture):

8 rectangles (A) 1 1/2 x 2 1/2"

16 squares (B) 1 1/2 x 1 1/2"

4 rectangles (D) 2 1/2 x 3 1/2"

4 rectangles (E) 1 1/2 x 4 1/2"

Light: 8 squares (B) 1 1/2 x 1 1/2"

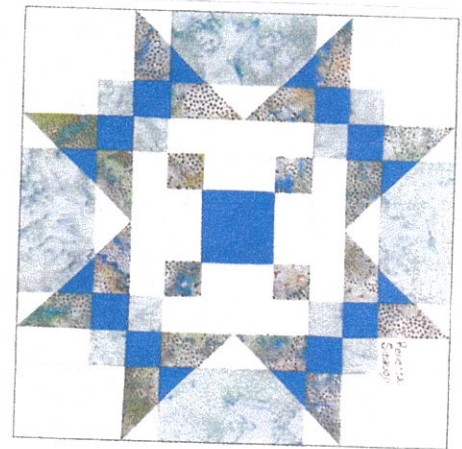
4 rectangles (C) 2 1/2 x 4 1/2"

Medium: 16 rectangles (A) 1 1/2 x 2 1/2"

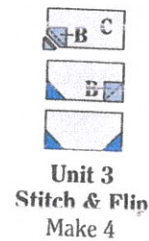
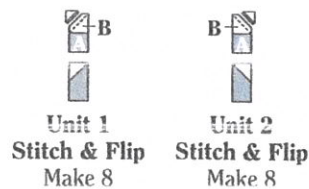
4 squares (B) 1 1/2 x 1 1/2"

Dark: 16 squares (B) 1 1/2 x 1 1/2"

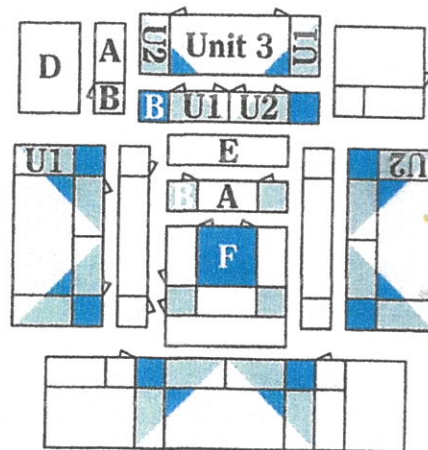
1 square (F) 2 1/2 x 2 1/2"



As shown in the diagrams below, "stitch, flip and trim" medium A's and background B's to make 8 unit 1's and 8 unit 2's as shown. Then make 4 unit 3's using the same method, using light C's and dark B's.



Sew the units and patches together as shown in the block assembly diagram below.
