I have chosen a disappearing 9 patch in red, white & blue. I will furnish the gold for the center square as I want it all the same. The gold block was passed out during the August guild meeting.

Disappearing Nine Patch

Disappearing Nine Patch quilts are designed by arranging and sewing together the units that form when a traditional nine patch quilt block of any size is sliced into four equal quarters.



Let's Simplify Disappearing Nine Patch Terminology:

- Original nine patch quilt block = the *parent* block
- The four sections cut from the original = the *daughter* blocks

Facts About the Quilt Blocks

- The outer four corners of the parent nine patch block remain squares in the daughters.
- The center square of the parent block becomes a small square at one corner of each daughter.
- The squares that sit at the outer midpoints of the parent block become narrow bars in daughters.
