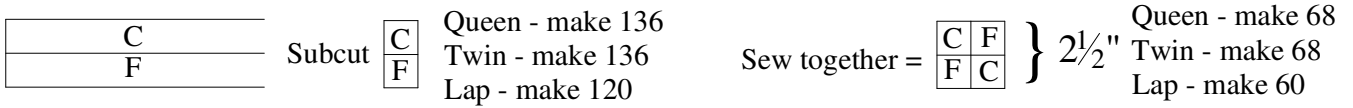


Musical Ride Mystery Quilt: Step 3

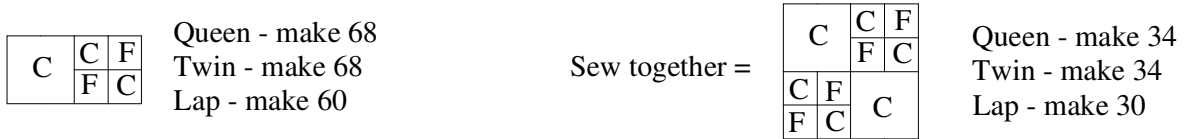

General Directions: Use ¼” seams throughout. It is best to use a ¼” foot on your machine. Use a dry iron (no steam) and press after each step. Once your quilt top is all assembled, it is ok to steam. Make sure to “measure twice and cut once”.

- a) Sew the 1½” ‘C’ strips to the ‘F’ 1½” ‘C’ strips. Sub cut into 1½” x 2½” pieces. Sew these 2-colour pieces together making 2-colour 4-patch squares. 4-patch squares should measure 2½” square.



- b) Sew a 2½” ‘C’ square to the 2½” 4-patch squares made in step a) above. Sew these together as shown below:



- c) -Queen & Twin only: Sew a small ‘B’ triangle (cut from the 2⅞” squares in the cutting directions) to each side of the 3⅜” ‘D’ squares. Make 4 of these “square in a square” pieces.
-Lap only: From remnant of fabric ‘A’, cut eight 2⅞” squares, cutting in half diagonally once, making 16 small triangles. Sew a small ‘A’ triangle to each side of the 3⅜” ‘D’ squares. Make 4 of these “square in a square” pieces.



- d) Twin & Queen only (skip this step if making the lap size):
-Sew the fourteen 8½” x 4½” ‘C’ pieces to the 14 made in Step 2d that were labelled as “Border Blocks #1” as shown:
